KINDNESS AND RESPECT



Try to get on with everyone and treat others as you would like to be treated.




Respect other people's appearance, opinions and feelings.

Include everybody and avoid any physical behaviour that might intimidate others.

Use manners: please/ thank-you, open doors for staff and students etc.

LEARNING




Act in a way that encourages mutual respect between staff and students.


Arrive on time with the correct equipment. Engage in lessons and behave in a way that promotes learning.

Complete work to the best of your abilities and meet homework deadlines. Ask your teacher for help when you need it.

Take responsibility for your organisation. If you need help with organisation speak to your teacher or tutor.



BULLYING AND RESPONSIBILITY



Understand that bullying of any type, whether emotional, verbal, physical, or cyber-bullying, is unacceptable.

Avoid behaving in a way that makes anyone around you feel excluded or intimidated.

If you know of bullying, do something about it - by talking calmly to the bully or telling an adult.


Be an upstander not a bystander; take responsibility for your actions.



If you experience bullying, tell a trusted adult.



ENVIRONMENT AND APPEARANCE




Take responsibility for your environment. Treat school property with respect and leave classrooms in a presentable state.


Only use property (including iPads, bags, lockers etc.) that is your own, and not take others possessions without permission.

Wear the correct uniform at all times. No nail varnish. Jewellery must be plain metallic: one simple necklace (pendant \leq 3cm), one bracelet per wrist, small earrings (studs or hoops \leq 2cm), and one ring per hand.

Take pride in your surroundings and don't litter or graffiti anywhere in school or beyond.



TECHNOLOGY



In class, only use your iPad as instructed by your teacher to engage in educational activities.

Follow the Acceptable Use Policy at all times including not using mobile phones in school (including at Late Stay except to make travel arrangements).

During the school day do not use your iPad to watch TV, non-educational videos, or play games.

Use technology respectfully: only take photos, make recordings or share materials with others' permission.
