- a) we will contact your child's current or previous school to ask for a reference (if applicable), including asking for information about any special educational needs your child may have and whether any school fees are outstanding (if applicable);
- b) we may ask for information about other schools to which you are applying because they may hold their entrance exam on the same day as ours;
- c) we will contact other people with parental responsibility to check that they consent to your child joining the Foundation;
- d) the Confidential Information Form will be used to ensure that we have made any reasonable adjustments/suitable arrangements for your child when they visit the Foundation or during any entrance assessments and subsequently if they are offered a place;
- e) we may share your information with credit reference agencies. We may also need to share information with UKVI as explained above.

If your child is not offered a place, or if you do not accept the offer of a place, we will only retain this information for as long as we need to. Unless there are exceptional circumstances, information is kept for a year after the end of the admissions process.
