

## Stephen Perse Foundation Code of Conduct - Early Years to Year 2

This Code of Conduct has been drawn up in consultation with our School Councils and is relevant to all children from Early Years up to Year 2.

### FRIENDLINESS

I will try to include everyone and not leave anyone out.	I will think about other people's feelings.	I will have kind hands, feet and words at all times. Hitting other people is unkind and not allowed.	I will show respect for everyone in my words and actions at all times.
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### LEARNING

I will speak to the adults if I need help.	I will always listen to the adults and my classmates and do the silent stop sign when needed.	I will try my best.	I will encourage my classmates.
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### PREVENTION OF BULLYING

I will treat others as I would like to be treated.	I will not allow or encourage others to be unkind.	If I know someone is being hurt I will do something to help.	I will not hurt others with my behaviour.
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### ENVIRONMENT

I will ask before I borrow something and I will always return it.	I will use the toys and equipment properly.	I will not take things that belong to the school or others. If I find something, I will take it to an adult.	I will keep my school tidy and put rubbish in the bin.
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### TECHNOLOGY

I will follow the adults' instructions when using the iPads.	I will follow the iPad rules at all times.	I will not take photos or videos of others without asking permission.	I will look after the iPads.
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### School Rules

- Unless special permission has been given to the contrary, school uniform must be correctly worn on all occasions. This includes the journey to and from school.
- The only jewellery permitted with school uniform is a watch. Students with pierced ears may wear earrings or sleepers in school if this has been formally agreed with the Head.
- All possessions must be clearly marked with the owner's name.
